Tuition Fee

If you are a student of either the United Methodist Church (UMC) or the United Church of Christ in the Philippines (UCCP), you can apply for tuition scholarship in a separate link after completing your admissions process.

Field Ed 1: Summer Immersion

All students are required to complete six weeks of service learning during the summer term (April–May). The amount indicated here is based on the standard rate; however, the actual cost may vary depending on the assigned placement area. A detailed breakdown of the fee will be provided by the Field Education Office.

Accommodation

The McLennan Cottages are intended for students accompanied by their families. A monthly fee of P2,500 is charged, exclusive of water and electricity costs. Priority is given to families with young children.

The Women's and Men's Dormitories are designated for unaccompanied or single students. Residents are charged P1,500 for twin-sharing rooms. Electricity charges are based on declared electrical appliances, while the water fee is fixed at P600 per semester.

Cost of Living in Dasmariñas

The cost of living in Dasmariñas City is generally lower than in Metro Manila, making it a relatively affordable place for students, young professionals, and families. A reasonable monthly budget depends on lifestyle and transportation needs.
